



## STANDING ORDER OF THE 24TH REGIONAL STUDENT CONVENTION

24th Regional Student Convention for School of Tomorrow program (hereinafter referred to as Convention) is held by International School of Tomorrow, Moscow, Russia, jointly with Accelerated Christian Education, Inc. for schools in Moscow, regions of the Russian Federation, CIS and Baltic countries in correspondence (distant) form from October 15, 2020, till April 15, 2021, in two stages and includes 58 events from various fields of knowledge.

Student Convention includes events in Academics, Photography, Music, and Platform. Choose events that will best develop your gifts and talents for Christian service.

### GOALS AND OBJECTIVES

---

The main goals and objectives of the Regional Student Convention for schoolchildren are:

- providing children from different schools, cities and countries with the opportunity to demonstrate their knowledge, skills and abilities in those areas of knowledge that are studied in English and in their native languages,
- promotion of scientific, cultural and social knowledge in English and Russian languages, spiritual and moral education,
- popularization of bilingual education among teachers and schoolchildren,
- popularization of additional education among teachers and schoolchildren,
- creating conditions for a deep and comprehensive study of the English language as a means of promoting education.

### ORGANIZATION PROCEDURES

---

The general management of the Regional Student Convention is carried out by the Organizing Committee of the Regional Student Convention (hereinafter the Organizing Committee) consisting of Director of the Regional Student Convention, Chief coordinator and coordinators for refereeing (Judge Master), technical support, public relations, transport, placement.

The organizing committee, within its competence:

- agrees and makes decisions on all issues related to with the organization of preparation and holding of the Regional Student Convention;
- defines the order of formation, approval and control over the execution of the budget of the Regional Student Convention;
- forms a methodological commission to determine the content Student Convention and ensuring the required scientific and methodological level its implementation;
- directly supervises the preparation and conduct of Regional Student Convention;
- approves the composition of the jury of the Regional Student Convention to submit methodological commission, the procedure for orientation and training of its members;
- analyzes and summarizes the results of the Student Convention, presents a report on the holding of the Regional Student Convention;
- attracts sponsorship (charitable and other) funds Russian and international organizations, as well as individuals for the purpose ensuring a higher level of Student Convention.

## **PARTICIPANTS**

---

A student of any school or home schooling group who have an agreement with International School

Tomorrow (Moscow, Russia) and use the School of Tomorrow program can become a participant of the Regional Student Convention;

Students are eligible for participation in this Convention if they were 9 years old or older by September 30, 2020, but were not past 18 years of age by this same date.

Students compete in two age groups: juniors - 9-12 years old, seniors - 13-18 years old. (The student's age as of September 30, 2020, determines their age category.)

All participants must follow the following requirements:

- meet with the requirements for the appearance and form of clothing of the participants of the Olympiad;
- compliance with age restrictions;
- follow the rules of each event.

## NUMBER OF EVENTS

---

For the Fall stage, a participant may present a maximum of 4 entries. The beginning date for registration of participants and their entries for the Fall stage remains to be announced. All entries are to be uploaded to the RSC program and/or to internet resources. The final date for submission of entries for the Fall competition is December 11, 2020.

For the Spring stage, a participant may present a maximum of 6 entries. Entries may be submitted for the Spring stage from January 15 through March 1, 2021.

## JUDGING

---

The judging of each event is carried out by the judging team, consisting of minimum two, and maximum of three people. Teachers of schools in Moscow, regions of the Russian Federation are involved in judging.

The judging period for the Fall stage is December 12-28, 2020. The Fall stage Awards Ceremony will be organized in ZOOM format and held not later than January 29, 2021.

The judging period for the Spring stage is March 1-30, 2021. The Spring stage Awards Ceremony will be organized in ZOOM format and held not later than April 15, 2021

Some Music and Platform Division entries may be judged over ZOOM.

The jury of each event of the Regional Student Convention decides on the following questions:

- checks and evaluates theoretical, experimental and practical, creative, textual, computer-simulated tasks of the participants on the corresponding judge's forms at the rate of 100 percent;
- after the end of judging, the chief judge in each event hands over the completed judge's forms to Judge Master.

All judges' decisions are final.

## THE COST

---

The cost of individual participation is 1000 rubles.

The cost of school participation (unlimited number of students) is 15000 rubles.

All payments should be made no later than December 1, 2020;  
access to the registration program must be preceded by payment.  
All payments are non-refundable.

## AWARDS

---

According to the results of the Regional Student Convention, medals can be awarded in each event for the first, second and third places. To win the first place, the participant must receive at least 80% for his performance, for the second place  
- not less than 70%, for the third - not less - 50%.

At the conclusion of the Spring and Fall stages of the Convention, two outstanding students of each age category will be awarded the honorable titles of The Boy of Convention 2021 and The Girl of Convention 2021.

The announcement of the names of the winners takes place at the rallies and awards ceremonies. After that ceremonies medals and trophies are sent to the schools of the participants.
